### State 12's and under Girls Team

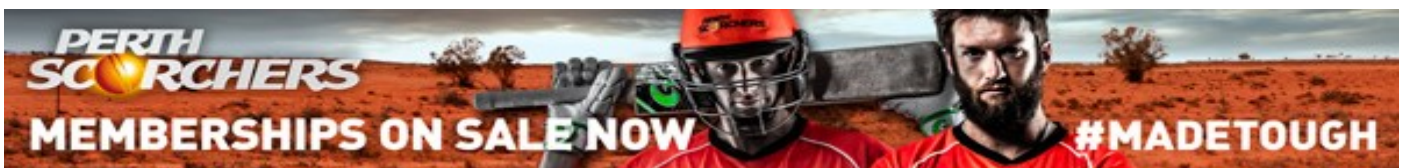
Free Come & Try session for Under 13's 24th October, 2015.
