Welcome to the penultimate newsletter for 2018. Following on from such a successful P&C fete in Week 5, we test drove our new remote controlled electric drop down screen at the last assembly. For this assembly, we tested the sound equipment for the first time. Mr Acott has done a fantastic job researching and project managing this major acquisition. My **thanks** go again to the **P&C** for raising these funds, and I will be hinting at the next P&C meeting what the school would like for our next major fundraising effort.



Speaking of acquisitions, the new **Nature Play** in the junior area has begun. Although the children have been reduced to half a play area, I noticed teachers taking the younger children to the senior nature play area, built by

the P&C a few years ago, to make up for the loss of space. It will all be worth it in Term 1, 2018 when Caralee & FLDC Kindy/Pre-Primary students have a fantastic NEW Nature Play area that had design input by staff to maximise outdoor play opportunities for our students.

This newsletter is all about major projects, as I am pleased to announce Caralee has been **successful** in our application for a **Specialist Science Laboratory**. Work on converting an existing room will occur during 2018 or 2019, depending on construction schedules. We will also receive \$25,000 to purchase science resources to equip the laboratory. Funding will be allocated to our school on completion of the refurbishment. These new facilities and resources will allow us to grow our science program and motivate and engage our students to excel from

Kindergarten right through to Year 6 and beyond. The existing LOTE (Languages other than English) room will be converted to the lab and will still be used for Italian. Importantly, the external historical cultural mural of the Noongar people in Willagee, and Austrian pre-fabrication home project that led to Willagee as we know it today, will remain. We will simply continue the mural (art project for Sam when he is better) which will be in the STEM (Science, Technology, and Engineering & Maths) future.

The last newsletter will be around the time of the graduation and award ceremony for Year 6 and hardworking and high achieving students. I look forward to seeing parents there.




Caralee's Got Talent
