Welcome everyone one to Term 3.

We sometimes use the saying, it will be a 'busy term' but Term 3 this year definitely fits that bill. The school chose to go back to this highly reputable provider for this important part of the Arts curriculum, based on teacher and parent feedback, and they thankfully had term 3 available. This does mean however, that we will be busy balancing athletics practice and swimming lessons later in the term.

As mentioned with **Athletics**, we traditionally start training this term with everyone participating in running trials for divisions and team game practice in factions. Last year, Gold won the outright shield, and Red won the team games shield (named after former Deputy Principal and sports co-ordinator, Mr Geoff Bailey). Our training sessions help identify selected students to represent the school in the Cockburn Districts School Sports Association (CDSSA) interschool carnival. I wish all the factions well in their preparations.

The last newsletter featured the **Colour Run** and numerous pictures of staff and students having a wonderful time all in the name of raising money for whole school mathematics and spelling program resources. I mentioned the amount raised was in excess of \$5000. With the final figures now in, the P&C in fact raised a whopping \$6,686. Again, my thanks go to the [P&C Fundraising Committee](#) and all those who participated.

On Monday, 29 July, our school was reviewed as part of the **Dept. of Education Public School Review** process conducted every three years. This was a new process starting in 2019, and the first review of any type for Caralee CS since 2009. Events like the Colour Run, and other fantastic P&C activities and enterprises, including the Uniform Shop and Caralee's Kitchen, were highlighted by P&C President, Julia Stewart, and Treasurer, Meredith Hathaway. Our School Board members were interviewed along with numerous community members and staff from both Caralee and FLDC. While the report is not yet published, it will be available on our website from Week 3, the verbal

feedback regarding **the progress the school has made across all areas of teaching, student performance and community engagement was outstanding**. My sincere thanks to all staff and community representatives who prepared submissions and spoke so well on the day. I was fortunate to speak at **Melville Senior High School's** Public School Review last term to validate their efforts supporting our community engagement activities in the library. I am again honoured to be invited to speak to more reviewers this time for the Secondary School Principal of the Year and the Secondary School of the Year as **Principal, Mr White and MSHS** have been nominated for these awards. As a former MSHS student myself, I will try not to be biased which is easy, because Melville SHS has provided great support for our transitioning students and pastoral care programs in the community.

One Big Voice is a choral festival aimed at promoting a love of singing, friendship, and acceptance as well as developing relationships with other children who share a love of music.

Our Caralee Choir has been selected to participate in the One Big Voice Festival Matinee, to be held at the RAC Perth Arena on Friday, August 30, 2019, commencing at 12 noon with Young Talent Pre-Show followed by the One Big Voice Choir at 12.30 pm.

This year, 7500+ students from 135 schools will be involved in the *One Big Voice* Festival, and will sing an exciting selection of festival songs. The children will leave school at 9.30am by bus to arrive at the RAC Arena at 10 a.m. for a 10.30a.m. rehearsal. Before the concert, they will be given a short break to ensure they are ready and energised for their performance.

Students will need to bring a snack in a disposable container. A small water bottle only is permitted inside. The children need to be wearing their choir shirts.

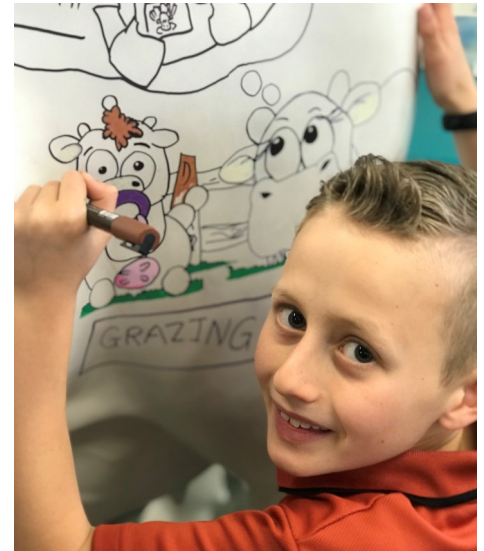
