I am pleased to announce that I have been informed that I am the successful applicant. Any promotional position in life is exciting but very few jobs also come with the responsibility that being Principal of a school brings. Although I was Acting Principal for nearly 18 months, being officially appointed the substantive Principal of Caralee CS is truly an honour and a privilege.

When I took over from Mr Anderson in 2016, I briefly introduced myself, family, hobbies and interests in Newsletter 1 2016 ([click to read](#)). Not much has changed since then, except I forgot to mention Bella, our dog, and Peggy, our rabbit!! Importantly, although the Principal process required an acknowledgement of the success our staff and students have had recently, a vision and plan for the future was an essential component. Our staff will be the first to hear of those plans in the coming weeks. I will be holding a parent

information session in conjunction with our School Council to outline those plans further.

The **School Council**, and the development of that group into a truly representative Governance institution for Caralee, has been a critical component for supporting our vision of 'Success for ALL' students at Caralee. School Council Chair, Karen Ramsay, was part of the Principal selection process and I am indebted to her for her support, time and effort in Chairing the Council and working with the Department of Education to choose a Principal. It is important to also recognise the role Peter Tinley MLA and ex-P&C President, Lachie Tuppin, played in securing a merit select process for Caralee. I thank them for their persistence and hard work. Together, all parts of the Caralee and Willagee community have worked hard to give the children of Willagee the best opportunity to achieve their academic and social potential.

Although Lachie Tuppin in no longer P&C President, he is still working hard to support the Caralee P&C. Lach now Chairs the canteen working group, which meets after school on Wednesdays. The working group aims to

support **Tracey Hunkin**, our Canteen Manager, with new menu ideas, special events menus and volunteer support. If you are interested, come to the office to find out more.

Stay tuned for more information about future plans for the next 10 years of success and Caralee.

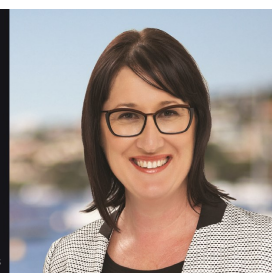
