We are past half way in Term 2 for 2017, and teachers are busily preparing **student reports** for semester one. I have been impressed with the learning opportunities our teachers are providing across the school as I visit classes, and look forward to reading all student reports in preparation for them going home in the last week of term.

Our AFL Ambassador of the Year, Ms Aleisha Cotton, kindly organised a team of Caralee children to attend the recent **AFL Indigenous Round**. A number of our Indigenous students were very lucky to be invited to participate in the half-time little league match between the West Coast Eagles and GWS. Our players won the day kicking one goal to the other team's one point. As well as getting to play in front of a crowd of 37, 750 people, our boys and girls got to form a guard for the GWS

senior team and returned to the ground to meet Eagles player, **Jordan Snadden**. The behaviour of our students was exemplary at all times and they got to see some great play up close. Big thanks go to Mr Darron Acott who gave up his time to supervise the children on the weekend, and who was ably supported by parents Tash Garrett and Amanda Headland.

Speaking of **Mr Acott**, he has recently been appointed as a permanent Deputy Principal to Caralee CS as of this week. This completes a long period of Acting DP's filling in my old substantive DP position while I was Acting Principal. Ironically, Mr Acott was first Acting DP in that period and won a position at Carnarvon DHS based on his good work here at Caralee. It is wonderful to have him back, and his expertise in music, and with Positive Behaviour Support (PBS), is a great asset to our school, and

I congratulate him on his appointment.

Finally, I had the great privilege last Friday to present former teacher, Ms **Jill Hopper**, with a Director General's medallion for service to public education in WA for 38 years.



Ms Hopper was, for many years, a Year 6/7 teacher at Caralee, and before that taught at Carawatha Primary School which amalgamated with Willagee Primary School to form Caralee Community School in 2005.

Ms Hopper was a wonderful teacher and gave her all for the children she taught. She retired due to ill health but was determined to come back to Caralee to receive her medal.

The staff and I wish Ms Hopper a happy and wonderful retirement, particularly now she has time to go the football and support the mighty Dockers, as she has been doing recently.

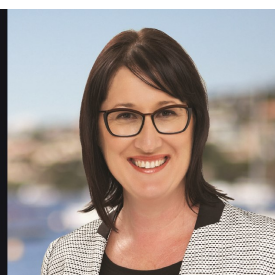
