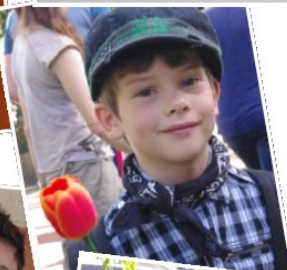
Harmony Day Breakfast held on the 21st was another resounding success. Over 400 parents and students enjoyed a tasty bacon and egg muffin.
