Thanks to all staff and community members that provided feedback and work on the submission. More details will follow regarding what IPS looks like for Caralee in 2019.

Our **School Council**, which will transition to a Board under IPS, met this week to discuss IPS and other matters. One topic was the NAPLAN data which was released this week. Caralee has again demonstrated achievement in Years 3 & 5 at expected or above level, which is a credit to our students and the work of our teachers and school staff. Parents will see where their child's results sit against the cohort tested, and sometimes people have questions about individual results. Given it was 'one test on one day', it has to be considered against your child's most recent school report. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the office.

Finally, the last big item was the **Caralee Parent Night** on Wednesday, 19th of September. There was a free sausage sizzle courtesy of **Winthrop Gardens IGA**, and all classes and specialist areas were open. Following this, if you require an in-depth discussion about your child's work, please book an appointment so teachers can speak to all parents in attendance. It was extremely gratifying to see so many people in the classrooms and enjoying the sausage sizzle.

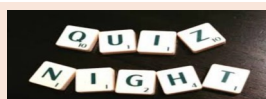
Install dual flush toilets
