Although this information evening is a free event – bookings are required as places will be limited (this is a closed event is not open to the general public). To make a booking please email:

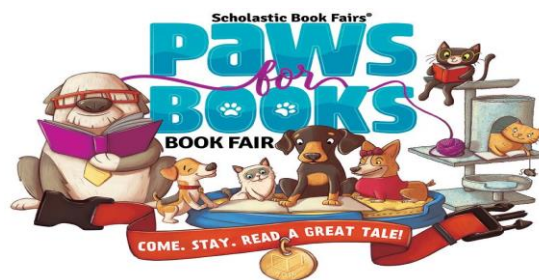
