Welcome to the end of Term 1 newsletter for 2019. We have had a great first term of the year, with students engaging in many meaningful experiences across the curriculum.

This week, we had our Student Leaders attend the Halogen Youth Leaders Conference in the city. They came away inspired by a number of speakers talking about leadership, and had the opportunity to engage with student leaders from other schools. Mrs Dow reports that our leaders did us proud in terms of behaviour and engagement with the activities on offer.

Parents with Health Care cards need to be aware that the City of Melville is ceasing Active Link vouchers for school based activities. You will still be able to get support for 'out of school' activities. If you have an existing voucher, it will be put towards camp for Year 6 students and swimming for everyone else. You still have until May 31<sup>st</sup> to request a voucher at the Willagee Community Centre before the school

activity component ends.

Caralee will be completing the NAPLAN tests 'online' in 2019, and Year 5 students will be typing the writing part this year for the first time. There has been a massive effort by CCS & FLDC Deputies and Cathy Bullock our Network Support Officer in preparation for this which has been going on since last year. Similarly, an appropriate amount of preparation has gone into preparing students for the online version. As I always say, 'It's just one test on one day' for individual students', but the whole school picture of NAPLAN shows our school is performing better than expected across a range of subjects.

Our P&C were active again this term with the AGM re-electing most of the Executives, and some new faces were welcomed to the team. Waffle day was again a big success and these special canteen events help ensure our canteen is open 5 days a week.

Our other parent body, the School Board, will meet for the first time late in the term to vote in a new President and ratify the Annual Report, which will be available next term on *Schools Online* (visit: [www.det.wa.edu.au/schoolsonline](http://www.det.wa.edu.au/schoolsonline)). The positive NAPLAN data (mentioned previously), and student achievements across the breadth of the curriculum, were a highlight as we prepared the report.

Quick reminder that our ANZAC ceremony is on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> of April, which is our last big event for the term before the holidays. Children who belong to service organisations such as Guides or Scouts are encouraged to wear their uniform that day. Parents and community members are always welcome to attend, and may assemble quietly from 9.15am for a 9.30 start.

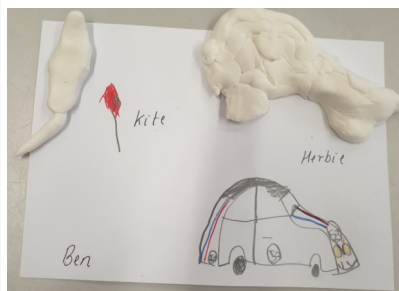

Our focus this term in **Visual Arts** is to learn how students' ideas can be developed through different forms, styles, techniques, materials and technologies, and we have been doing this through "Creative Imagination Play". Whether it's linked in with turning a simple line into a house or mountain, or be given soft clay to turn into whatever the imagination can create.

Each class has received an "Imagination Workout" assessment where they use their creative skills to complete the drawing using lines and shapes provided in each box. Students are to think "outside the box" and give their imagination a workout. We have also linked in a literacy work out, where students can add a story to support their design.
