

INTERSCHOOL TEAMS SELECTION PLAN

STATEMENT

The Caralee School Board and school staff agrees that the most deserving students should have the opportunity to represent their school for interschool sport events.

PROCEDURE:

Summer and Winter Interschool Teams

Interschool summer and winter sport teams are selected by the Deputy Principal responsible for sport based on:

- All year 6 students selected first, regardless of performance, as the competition is for year 6 students (generally applies to Winter Sport/Eagles Cup events);
- Where positions in teams become available, year 5 and 4 students with the ability and size to compete safely against year 6 students, subject to parental permission, can be selected;
- Ability, where year group specific events are being conducted e.g. MSHS yr4/5 netball competition etc. and,
- Student's ability to demonstrate responsible behaviour and be a good sport in line with school's positive behaviour plan.

Athletics Teams

Interschool athletics teams are selected by the Deputy Principal responsible for sport based on:

- Running results in the championship races at the Athletics Carnival;
- Timed/measured training sessions associated with the carnivals; and
- Student's ability to demonstrate responsible behaviour and be a good sport in line with school positive behaviour plan.

Athletics Carnival – Champion Medals

Championship medals and runner-up medals are awarded to students who collect points in championship events for jumps, throws, distance running events and championship age race at the athletics carnival.

Children are selected for championship races and events after multiple trials during junior/senior sport and PE lessons.

The point system for championship events is:

First – 8 pts, Second – 5 points, Third – 3 points and Fourth – 1 points

Placegetters in championship events will be in contention for interschool selection. The judges say on places during events is final and no appeals will be entered into outside the judge's decision.

SUMMARY

Students who represent our school for interschool sport are chosen based on the plan outlined. Our primary focus is for students to exhibit our core values when competing by being *responsible*, being *respectful* and being their *best*. Under extenuating circumstances, the administration team may take other factors into account when making individual and team selections. Parents or carers should consult the school, after referring to this plan, if they have any queries or concerns regarding interschool team selection.
