

## Contributions and Charges 2026

All schools are required to inform parents of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the new school year. These costs have been approved by the School Board and are divided into three areas: Voluntary Contributions, Personal Items (Student Requirements), Charges and other Optional Costs.

## **School Contributions**

The financial support provided by parents plays a significant role in the provision of resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to students' learning experiences. Contributions are voluntary; however, they do form an essential component of annual funding. The quality of our learning programs is therefore maximised when each family contributes.

**The voluntary contribution** for *all* students is **\$60 per student**, which aligns with the School Education Regulations 2000.

At Caralee Community School, voluntary contributions examples of how funds are directed and used to purchase supplementary materials and resources for students are detailed below in the following table.

These events are planned to be cost neutral i.e. what the school pays is charged to parents.
